Overview:

This project was a complete bridge replacement located on Tahawus rd. (CR25) in the town of Newcomb approximately 6.5 miles from the intersection with the Blue Ridge rd. (CR84). The existing 160' long x 19'-3" wide temporary Mabey truss bridge was constructed in 2020 and placed over the existing 100' long x 25' wide steel girder bridge on concrete abutments & pier built in 1941. The new structure that was constructed was a single-span 125' long x 27'-4" wide and is comprised of 4 NEBT beams. This project was awarded the 2024 APWA Capital Branch project of the year in the structures category for projects less than 5 Million.
