

**ESSEX COUNTY  
STATE OF EMERGENCY ORDER  
NUMBER 2  
DATED APRIL 14, 2020**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Essex has declared a State of Emergency effective March 10, 2020, as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic which State of Emergency was extended on April 9, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the original State of Emergency and its first extension, Emergency Orders number 1 containing 8 subparagraphs were enacted; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Essex is desirous of adding the herein below set forth Emergency Order Number 2.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that during the period of the current state of emergency and any amendments thereto unless this Order is rescinded every effort to protect life and property and bring the emergency situation under control, the following additional Emergency Order shall be in full force and effect from **April 14, 2020 to April 19, 2020.** This Order shall continue for five (5) days unless rescinded:

**1. In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of our transfer station attendants and our residents, Essex County will temporarily not be accepting recyclables delivered to the stations by private individuals for the period of April 14, 2020 through April 30, 2020, as the exchange of these recyclables between persons is dangerous and unsafe.**

**Essex County will continue to receive recyclables, if delivered by truck and commercial haulers, provided that the recyclables can be dumped into the transfer station without contact with the transfer agent.**
